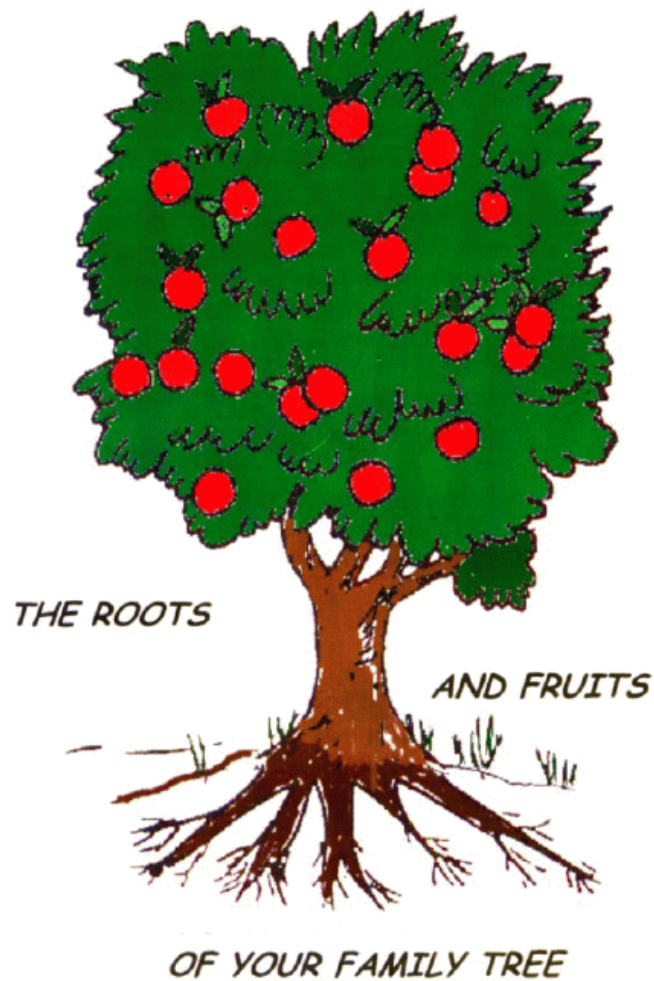

Ten golden rules

WHAT TO RECORD ON A PEDIGREE CHART

1. **Start with yourself** (or you could start with a spouse, parent, child as #1)
2. Work from known to unknown
3. Males on even numbers
4. Females on uneven numbers
5. Write forename and then the surname
6. Surnames in CAPITALs
7. Use female maiden names
8. Write date—DD Mmm YYYY
9. Record your source—so we all know how you know what you know!
10. Record place in full—town, parish/region, county/state, country

MORE POPULATION.

A reporter who went on board the Ruapehu this morning found the third-class quarter a lively scene. On a mild scale the picture could suggest visions of the old days, when immigrants with their wives and families flocked to New Zealand by the shipload. Children of all sizes romped about, dodging around mothers, who did not look displeased to find that the voyage had ended. In the steerage division there were 147 adults, 38 children of fair size, and 4 infants. The women totalled 56, including 27 married.

The men were mostly of a good stamp, and there was a healthy light of hope

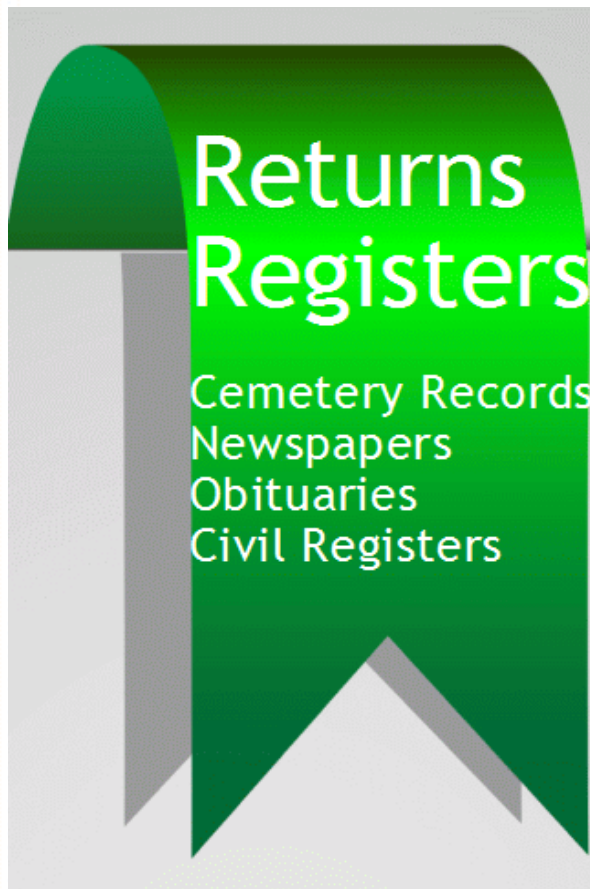

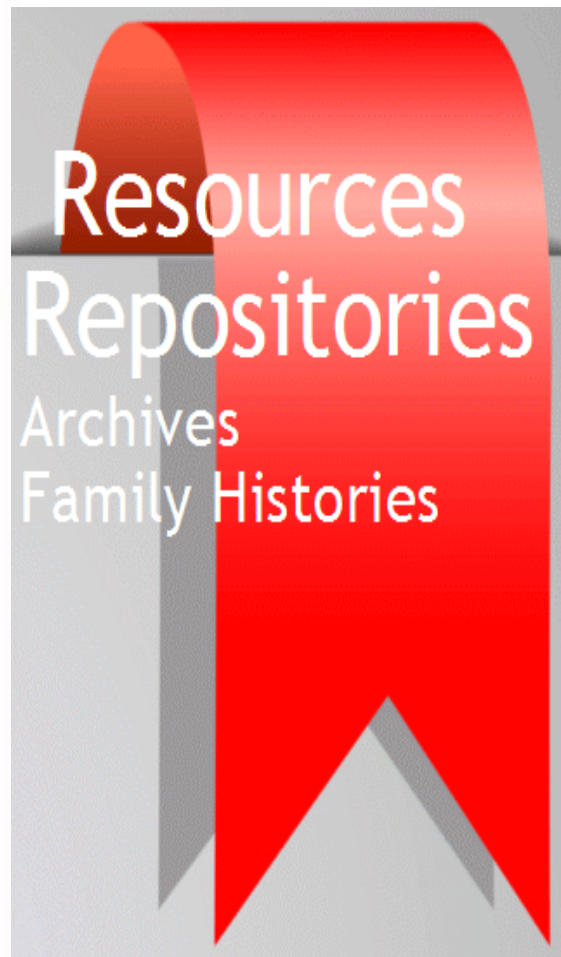
